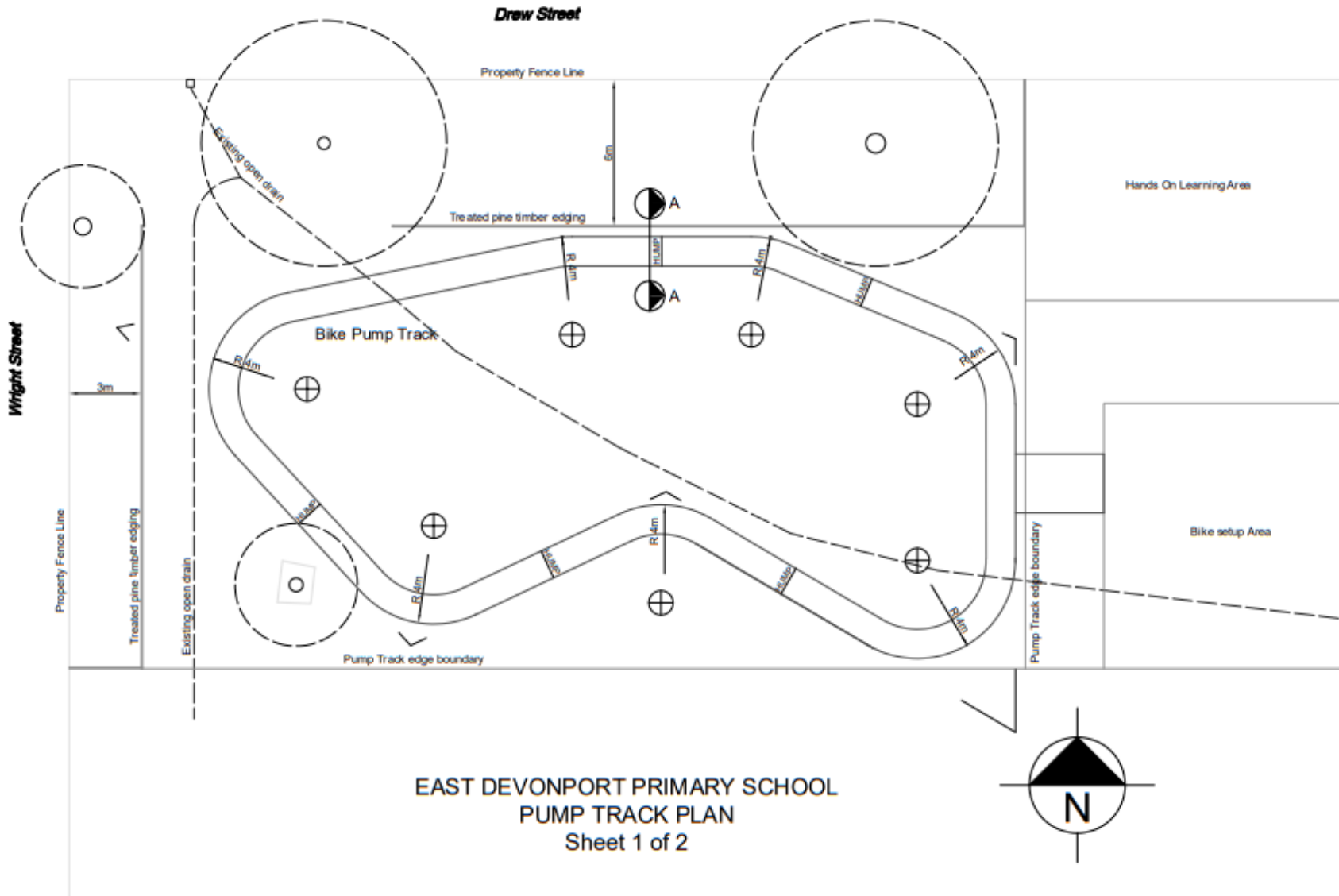

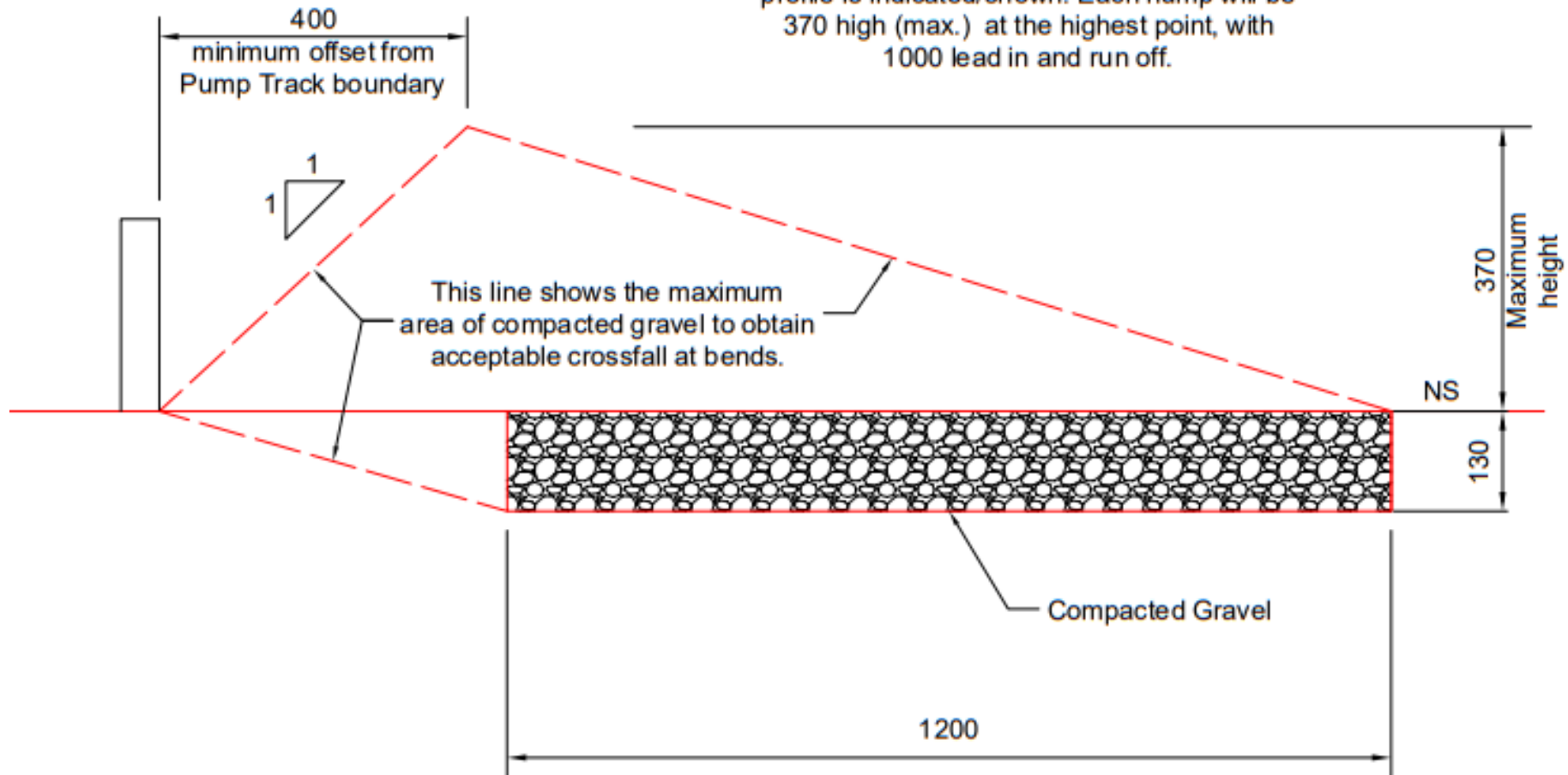




EAST DEVONPORT PRIMARY SCHOOL
